## Reno Pops Orchestra COVID- 19 Policy June 29, 2021

The Reno Pops Orchestra Board has been following protocol guidelines from the CDC for COVID-19.

As a result the Board has voted, unanimously, to require the following:

- For ALL players, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status, to wear a mask and for woodwinds and brass to use a bell cover or other approved mitigation efforts on your instrument for any indoor rehearsals.
- For outdoor rehearsals, masks and bell covers are optional for vaccinated individuals or for those who have obtained proof of COVID 19 antibodies, but are required for those who are unvaccinated.
- The Orchestra will provide hand sanitizer and wipes at the rehearsal space.
- All players are asked to do a self-check prior to every rehearsal. Your fellow Orchestra members are asking if you have signs of any illness, or have had any recent possible contact with someone who has COVID, that you stay home.
- If you are not willing (or able) to follow these guidelines, the Board respectfully requests you not play this concert.

\*\*\*The board will reassess these guidelines on an as-needed basis, depending on the masking regulations for Washoe County, the State of Nevada, and current NAfME and NFHS guidelines.
