PARTNERS IN EDUCATION

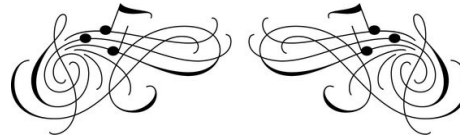
The Reno Pops Orchestra and the Washoe County School District have formed a partnership through the *Partners in Education* program to enable this fine camp to continue to thrive and grow.

CAMP SESSIONS

Classes will be offered during three sessions held daily, 9:00AM - 2:00PM, Monday through Friday. Campers are encouraged to attend all three sessions, and will choose which classes interest them when registering. During these sessions, students will participate in sectionals, master classes, and various ensembles including, but not limited to:

- Orchestra
- Wind Ensemble
- Jazz Ensemble
- Mariachi

Ensembles are subject to change due to instrumentation.



CAMP DIRECTOR

Jose Flores has been the Director of the Summer Music Camp for 23 years, and has been teaching bands and orchestras in the Washoe County School District for this same period of time. He is on the UNR Music Department Faculty, and was the past Music Director of the Reno Philharmonic Youth Concert Orchestra. He has received numerous awards and recognitions including: 2002 Excellence in Education, Teacher of the Year 2006, and Teacher Fellow Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts/National Symphony Orchestra. His newly created Mariachi Class was recognized as the 2014 Outstanding Club of the Year at UNR.

Various Washoe County School District teachers, retired teachers, Reno Pops Orchestra musicians, and local music students from UNR will assist with sectionals, master classes, private instructions, and ensemble opportunities.
